Gary & Dixie Clawson Scholarship

Recipients must be students in the Speech Language Pathology major, demonstrate characteristics of service through previous efforts in their personal community and financial need.

The Eleanor M. Foley Scholarship

Recipients must be students in the COMDDE major, demonstrate financial need who would not likely be able to afford college without additional funding. Students should also have an outstanding record of community, departmental, or university service.

The Joanne Lillywhite Christensen Endowment in Communicative Disorders

Established by Mrs. Ray L. Lillywhite in memory of her daughter, Joanne Lillywhite Christensen. These awards, known as Lillywhite Scholars, are awarded to either undergraduate or graduate students who achieve academic distinction in speech-language pathology.

The Leon G. & Faye Sonne Stucki Scholarship

Recipients must be a student majoring in the Communicative Disorders and Deaf Education department with a junior class standing and a grade point average of 3.0 or better.
