KINESIOLOGY AND HEALTH SCIENCE Scholarships

Application Deadline for all Scholarships is February 1, 2017

It is expected that all scholarship recipients write a Thank-you letter to the donor and a copy is to be attached to their acceptance letter and kept on file.

Mary Jane Faylor Scholarship

This scholarship is for **junior female** students majoring in *Kinesiology and Health Science* who have attained high scholarship, ethical standard, and are involved in departmental, campus, and community activities.

Raymond J. Foley Scholarship

Recipients should be students majoring in the *Kinesiology and Health Science* who demonstrate financial need who would not likely be able to afford college without additional funding. Preference will be given to student athletes who have demonstrated perseverance in the face of difficult challenges.

H.B. and Ethel Hunsaker Scholarship

This scholarship is for *Kinesiology and Health Science* majors who have attained high scholarship, ethical standard, and are involved in departmental, campus and community activities.

John Kras Scholarship

This scholarship is for a *Physical Education/Teaching Major* with preference given to a junior or senior level male student with a minimum GPA of 3.0. The student's main focus should be on teaching physical education in the public school system.

Conway L. Maughan & Rula H. Maughan Scholarship

This scholarship is for undergraduate students in *Human Movement Sciences* with a Pre-Physical Therapy emphasis, demonstrate a desire to further their studies at a graduate level in a related field and maintain a 3.0 GPA.

Dick Motta Scholarship

This scholarship is for **junior or senior** students majoring in *Physical Education Teaching*, *with a Coaching Emphasis*. Applicants must demonstrate academic achievement, financial need, and personal integrity.

Nelson Challenge

This scholarship is for *Parks and Recreation majors* who have <u>completed</u> their **junior** year. Applicants need to demonstrate involvement in professional associations, clubs in the parks and recreation field, and show potential as a future professional.

Dale O. Nelson Scholarship

This scholarship is for a student majoring in *exercise science or physical therapy* maintaining a minimum gpa of 3.0 and demonstrates financial need.

Olympic Scholarship

Applicants must be majoring in one of the following fields:

Community Health with a minimum 3.5 GPA. Exercise Science with a minimum 3.5 GPA Parks and Recreation with a minimum 3.0 GPA Pre-Physical Therapy with a minimum 3.5 GPA

The minimum GPA should be a cumulative average between all transcripts, including transfer schools, and first and second bachelors degrees. Applicants should also demonstrate financial need.

Melvin R. Parks Scholarship

This scholarship is for students majoring in *Health Education and Promotion*.

Ted and Marge Seeholzer Scholarship

This scholarship is for **junior or senior** students majoring in *Physical Education Teaching* and planning to be a physical education teacher. Candidates must demonstrate academic achievement, financial need, and personal integrity.

Thomas A. Stewart & Kathleen Stewart Scholarship

This scholarship is for *Human Movement Science Majors* with an emphasis in Pre-physical Therapy, demonstrate a financial need, display leadership skills and maintain a 3.0 GPA. Preference will be given to students who desire to teach.
