Effective with summer semester 2016, The Emma Eccles Jones College of Education and Human Services was approved to collect differential tuition on college courses. We appreciate the support that our students have given us through differential tuition to improve their educational experiences and programs of study. Funds received from differential tuition were directed to seven critical need areas for the college: accreditation, compliance, course fees/differential tuition replacement, graduate and undergraduate student research, graduate assistantships and tuition waivers, program enhancements, and technology support in student labs/clinics. In fiscal 2018, the funds were distributed to these categories as shown below.
